2. DoC Concession Fee Review	Letter sent by DoC to all clubs on 19 <sup>th</sup> August	
	RMCA have asked that all clubs dispute this fee as it is a 52% increase for some clubs.

	RMCA asked DoC for a copy of the valuation used for the concession fee review. DoC refused but once it was pointed out that a clause in our license entitle all clubs to a copy of the valuation they sent to all clubs. Again, please let us know if you have not received the valuation report.	
	Phill Thomas proposed a resolution that clubs give approval to RMCA Council to engage valuer should it be needed as part of the dispute process Seconded: Jo Bouchier
